TRIP SUMMARY & ITINERARY

DAYS 1 - 2

Arrive in Christchurch and head to the central business district (CBD) for your Red Bus city tour. Following your CBD tour, attend an educational program at the University of Canterbury to learn about earthquake research work being done there.

GET LOST IN THE STARS AT THE SOUTHERN HEMISPHERE'S ONLY DARK SKY RESERVE

Transfer to Tekapo for an afternoon of fun at the Tekapo Hot Pools, ice skating and swimming. Enjoy a short hike up Mount John, and admire the gorgeous views of Lake Tekapo! Arrive at your accommodation in Glenntanner, and take in the best night skies in New Zealand!



DAYS 3 - 4

Visit Mt. Aoraki Park and the Department of Conservation for an education programme to learn about the landforms and human impact within the park. Then, walk to the nearby glacier lake for a boat tour, exploring the Tasman Glacier. Transfer to beautiful Queenstown in the afternoon.

LEARN ABOUT CURRENT ENVIRONMENTAL PRESSURE AND CONSERVATION EFFORTS

Explore Queenstown's town centre before boarding the TSS Earnslaw. Take the breathtakingly beautiful ride across Lake Wakatipu to Walter Peak and have the best BBQ buffet lunch in town. Upon your return, head up the iconic Skyline gondola and test your speed on the luge track.

DAY 5

Enjoy Sunday brunch in Queenstown and get any last minute photos before heading home. Depart from Queenstown airport with memories to last a lifetime!
